## New DOCTOR and Clinical Nurse Practitioner (CNP) Update



The NSHA has hired Dr. Graeme Kohler to be responsible for Doctor and CNP recruitment for the Central Zone in NS, replacing Dr. Rick Gibson. Dr. Kohler and Barbara have met to review a new location for a medical clinic. We are actively recruiting a Physician to supervise the nurse

practitioner as well as provide care. We have expressions of interest from 2 CNP's but they will have to go through the hiring process once the location is settled and a supervising doctor is secured. I have requested that the Liberal promise of a collaborative health centre that was promised to our area during the last election be honored and that the budget for this centre be included in the Spring 2018



Principal Savage reported that the school transition questionnaire given to students in Grade 11 at Cole Harbour High (CHH) revealed that most students wanted to finish out grade 12 at CHH. This recommendation was made to the School Board as well as providing bussing for these students next year. Students who would be going to the IVHS who want the IB or Skills Trade programs will have to apply for out of area transfers, but bussing services may only be available if there is any



space for curtesy bussing. The IVHS Enhancement Committee will have several fund-raising events coming up and we will be looking for lots of donations & volunteers!

# Auburn & Cole Harbour High School and Feeder School Review Process

I have requested an update from Education Minister Zach Churchill about the fate of all Cole Harbour Schools but there has been no response to date. We do not know who will make the final decisions about the school as Zach Churchill has sent a directive to all School Boards including the HRSB advising them to NOT make any significant decisions



because of the Glaze Report Recommendations. The Liberal Government will be moving to terminate the HRSB and move power and authority to other volunteer and government bodies.

### **Home Town Hero Missy Searl**



# Open meeting at MLA office with Parents and Teachers Held



As you are aware, the Liberal Government commissioned the Glaze Report on the NS Education System and the School Boards. The report was released in early January 2018 and the government moved to immediately accept all 22 recommendations. This decision calls for the removal of English speaking school boards, Principals and Vice Principals from the unions and many other changes to the over – sight of teachers and schools that will place more power in the hands of the Minister of Education. The response from the NS Teachers Union and Teachers has been swift and a strike vote was called for February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

The NS Legislature has been called back in a month early to pass the Liberal Government's Education Bill. I hosted an open meeting at my office on Feb 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> 2018 to parents and teachers who wanted to share their fears, concerns and recommendations about the Glaze Report's recommendations.
